

CDBG PROJECT UPDATE FOR CAROLINA AVENUE AND SUTTLE STREET AREA:

The rehabilitations of the homes located at 419 Carolina Avenue, 415 Carolina Avenue and 412 Carolina Avenue are complete.



New interior doors, interior painting, new flooring and wall-to-wall carpeting, new cabinets, new handicap accessible bathroom fixtures, new vinyl windows and siding and a new heating and air conditioning system are just some of the renovations made to the home at **419 Carolina Avenue.**



Some of the improvements made to the home at **415 Carolina Avenue** include installation of gutters and downspouts; storm doors, vinyl replacement windows; new handrails and guardrails on the porch and rear steps; new bathroom fixtures that are handicap accessible; installation of smoke detectors and outdoor lighting; and installation of a new central heating and air conditioning system.



The home at **412 Carolina Avenue** got a new roof; gutters and downspouts; vinyl siding along with a new steel door and storm doors were installed; vinyl replacement windows and new insulation were added; bathroom fixtures were replaced with new ones and are handicap accessible; plus smoke detectors and outdoor lighting were added and a new central heating and air conditioning system was installed.



Utility improvements in the area include an upgrade to the sewer system that was completed in the fall of 2006. The storm drain improvements and repairs will begin in the spring of 2007.

The City is now putting together the final plans for a community park to be located at the corner of Carolina Avenue and Suttle Street with completion by the end of this year. In the Spring of 2006 the City began to demolish the Carolina Avenue Apartments and the Max Shoe store in preparation to construct this community park.
