Shelby City Park is comprised of 150 acres of beautifully kept Ball Fields, Playground, Picnic Areas, Aquatics Center, Nine-Hole Golf Course, Tennis Courts, Outdoor Volleyball & Croquet Court, Horse Shoes, and a Sitting Garden. In May 1947, City Park project began with surveying, planning and purchasing of property to build a Community Center as a memorial to those who served in World War II. On July 1st, 1948, The Commission had been formally set up and the building construction began to take place.

For a number of years, City Park has been the site of the "Foothills Merry-Go-Round Festival" and plays host to many large company picnics and special events.

Recreation & Sports Complex



The Shelby City Park Recreation & Sports Complex was dedicated on June 17, 2011 in a ceremony attended by hundreds. The complex includes 3 multi-purpose sports fields, warm-up area, playground, picnic shelter, walking track and horseshoe pits.

Holly Oak Park 704-484-6824

Purchased July 8th, 1949, five acres were transformed into a local park for added community enjoyment. A Recreation Center was built and dedicated on July 1st, 1959, and now contains a Gym with stage and a lobby containing a pool table, table tennis, air hockey and children's board games. In addition, Holly Oak Park has a softball field, two refurbished fishing ponds, nature trail, large picnic pavilion, outdoor volleyball, horse shoes and playground.

Carrousel & Rotary Train 704-484-6476

Shelby's City Park Carrousel (circa 1919) is one of a very few 'year-round' carrouseles in a traditional park location. The Carrousel features thirty-two jumping horses, twenty-eight colorful hand painted rounding boards and scenery panels. An authentic working Carrousel Band Organ provides stirring music. The "new" Carrousel opened in October 1998.

Shelby's City Park Rotary Train is a special thrill that holds momentous value with many in this community, as it was a purchase of the Shelby Rotary Club members and The City of Shelby in 1952. Every piece was meticulously rebuilt and brought up to like-new standards.

Along the way, many local businesses and individuals made valuable contributions of time, expertise and money. After years in storage, planning, and lots of labor, the Shelby Rotary Train, tunnel and track were restored in 2000.

Royster Memorial Golf Course was developed after the purchase of approximately 50 acres by the City of Shelby from Dr. & Mrs. S.S. Royster on April 26, 1948. The 50 acres are situated across piedmont flat lands which have propagated a variety of mountainous holes along the course. Royster Memorial offers many different programs for local patrons such as golf tournaments every Monday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday, Adult Golf leagues and Adult & Youth instructional lessons.
