Re: Homicide Update

On October 12, 2015 at 4:23 a.m. the Shelby Police Department received a 911 call in reference to a shooting at the Super 8 Motel located at 1716 E. Dixon Blvd. When officers arrived they located 35 year old Travis Dwayne Wallace in room 218 with a gunshot wound. Paramedics arrived on the scene where the victim was later pronounced dead. After an extensive investigation by the Shelby Police Department, Union County Sheriff's Department, Union County Public Safety, and the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Department the following individuals have been arrested and are being held with no bond in the Union County Jail in South Carolina. This case is still actively being investigated with the possibility of further arrest.
