Re: Shooting

On March 27, 2016 at 1:36pm Officers with the Shelby Police Department were dispatched to 1015 Earl Street in regards to a shooting. Upon the officer's arrival they found an individual identified as Dennis Williams (6326 Hullins Rd. Charlotte) suffering from one gunshot wound. The victim was transported to Carolina's Health Care System Cleveland where he is receiving treatment for his wounds.

As a result of the investigation Montrell Murray (26yoa), 525 S. Dekalb Street Shelby was identified as a suspect in this case. Detectives have obtained warrants on Murray for Assault with a Deadly Weapon Inflicting Serious Injury with Intent to Kill and Possession of a Firearm by a Felon. This investigation is ongoing with further charges possible.
