**AVAILABILITY**

Sewer service will be furnished to industrial customers not within the corporate limits of Shelby, if access to existing City facilities is feasible.

**RATE**

**A. CUSTOMERS RECEIVING FULL REQUIREMENTS SHELBY CITY WATER SERVICE**

Customer Charge Per Water Consumption Unit	\$ 250.40 per billing period
Volume Charge (Per 1,000 gallons)	\$ 3.95

**CONDITIONS**

Customer must use a minimum of 1,000,000 per billing period to be eligible for this rate.

Sewer service billing for customers who receive all water used from the City water supply system, is normally based on the entire amount of water metered and delivered by the City.

In the event that a person or corporation discharging industrial wastes into the City sanitary sewer system produces evidence to the City Manager that more than 10% of the total annual volume of water used for all purposes does not reach the City sanitary sewer, an estimated percentage of total water consumption to be used in computing charges may be agreed upon between the City Manager and the persons discharging industrial wastes into said sewer.

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Shelby, Chapter 44 Article IV, Sections 44-121 through 44-230, covers restrictions on the discharge of wastes into the City sewer system and surcharge(s) for the treatment of wastes which are potentially harmful to the system and/or involve extra processing costs.
